Safeguarding at Purcell

As part of our desire to ensure that your children are safe, happy and healthy whilst at Purcell, we have a strong pastoral and safeguarding team who work across the school to ensure that all children, regardless of their have the best outcomes. We at Purcell believe that all students have a right to be safeguarded from harm and exploitation regardless of race, ethnicity, age, gender or disability. Every member of staff is trained in Safeguarding and Child Protection in order to better recognise children in need and to help accordingly.

Our Safeguarding Team is headed by **Ziggi Szafranski**, who is the School's Designated Safeguarding Lead, or **DSL**. His deputy DSLs are **Paul** Bambrough (Principal), Tom Burns (Vice Principal), Lady Kate Cayley (Director of Boarding), Paul Hoskins (Director of Music), Sally-Ann Whitty (SENCO), and Debbie Shah (Accompanist). They work with the wider pastoral team, which includes Houseparents and other House staff, the Medical Team (School Nurses Hilary Austin and Carol Morgan, School Counsellor Nicky Morris and Physiotherapist Dr. Sarah Upjohn) and the students' Tutors.

On the school website, we have a section dedicated to Current Parents (accessible directly via <u>this link</u>) which contains some fact sheets that we have produced to help you understand some of the challenges facing children.
